



Walk 3 Lizzie's Lane

This walk takes you into the fields on the SouthWest of Redgrave down to the river which flows out of Redgrave Lake. Then along Lizzie's Lane in the valley between the village and Botesdale and back up the hill and into the village.

2.75 miles. We measure our walks and then give a time based on a walking speed of two and a half miles per hour. This is a realistic speed with time to see the view and chat. So, an hour and a quarter.

Turn left a out of the Cross Keys, across The Green and walk between the shop and the pond. b Very soon, before the church, take the footpath on the right at the end of Glebe Cottage. This takes you into the meadows on the south west side of the village.c

d On the other side of the meadow, through the hedge, the path takes you left, past a pond and onto the track down to the river, turn right e onto it and walk down to the river.f

Do not cross the river but turn left and walk along the bank. After a little while you drop down into the next field and bear left.

Leaving the river you now have a ditch on your left and walk towards Redgrave lake on Lizzie's Lane.g Two footpaths join from the right and at the second one you turn left, back up the hill towards Redgrave.h

i The track takes you in between houses, bends right j and crosses the road. Walk across the Flat Iron k and turn left on Half Moon Lane. I Keep going and you will soon see the All Saints Church (Blue Cross on the window)

Bare right along the road. m Back between the pond and the shop and there is The Green and The Cross Keys ahead of you.
